Thank you for your interest in joining our Hygiene Drive. Providing essential items for families and children is one of the many ways we show up for families experiencing homelessness.

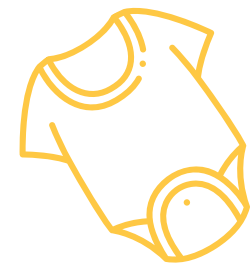
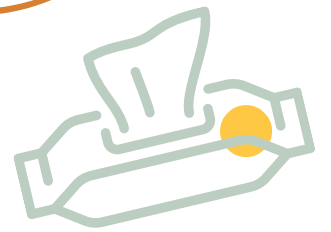
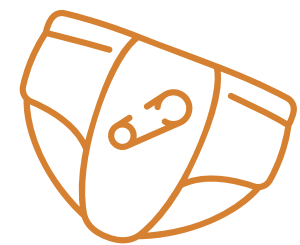
